Tour Details:

Go and discover and enjoy the natural beauty of the Western Cape (Stellenbosch, Boland & Overberg regions) whilst we take you on beautiful, interesting and spectacular main & back roads.

We are repeating this tour after the inaugural one was hosted in 2024. The natural beauty of the regions, especially those in lesser known areas, has mesmerised many of our clientele, whilst the pictures taken on tour and placed on our Facebook have led to many people asking us to repeat the tour. On this Road Trip you'll travel where people normally do not go and you'll see and experience another beautiful side of the Boland & Overberg.

You'll sleep at one venue, in a guest house in Stellenbosch, and travel daily in a circular route. In total you'll traverse **more than 45** mountain passes - on both tar and gravel. You do NOT need a 4x4 to go on this Road Trip. The routes are NOT technical and with easy to drive.

Travel through towns that you normally just sped pass or don't know exist; like Greyton, Pniel, Kommetjie, Stanford, Genadedal, Kleinmond and many more!

We'll stop en route for sightseeing, snacks, road stalls, photo's, toilets, coffee/tea, tourist destinations and less familiar places. Enjoy the drive and ride in your own vehicle.

At night and en route you'll have the opportunity to mix, mingle and have fun with the other people on tour.

This tour is in the spring season – perhaps we are fortunate to see lots of daisies and other flowers. The vineyards and orchards will be in its splendid beauty with fresh leaves and flowers. A visit to the West Coast National Park (in flower season) is part of the itinerary!

Departure & Return Location: The Road Trip starts in Stellenbosch. Depart daily from the guest house in Stellenbosch where we'll be staying for all six nights. No need to travel with all your luggage daily.



TRAVEL OPTIONS:

OPTION # 1: If you live in up-country (in the Gauteng, Limpopo, Mpumalanga or Northwest provinces) and you would like to travel in your own vehicle to the Western Cape, you can travel along with the tour leader, over two nights. (See more Info at the end of this memo).

People from other provinces can join en route.

OR

OPTION # 2: If you live in up-country (in the Gauteng, Limpopo, Mpumalanga, Northwest provinces or from any other place) and would like to travel in your own vehicle to the Western Cape and travel on your own you can meet us at Stellenbosch at the guest house on Sunday. Perhaps you can look up and visit friends or family before joining the tour.

OR

OPTION # 3: If you live up-country, you can **fly to Cape Town**, rent a vehicle, meet us at Stellenbosch and travel along. Any vehicle is suitable for these routes & roads. These would be for your own arrangements. After the tour you fly back OR join us for the Southern Cape Mountains Passes tour.

OR

OPTION # 4: This Western Cape Road Trip is immediately followed by the **Southern Cape Mountain Passes Road Trip** (8 days) in the George, Knysna & Oudtshoorn region where you'll be able to traverse more than 60 mountain passes. (See more Info at the end of this memo). Join the Southern Cape tour as well and travel back to Gauteng with the tour leader or continue on your own journey.

Note: During 2024 most of the people made use of combining **Options 1 & 4**. I.e.: Travelled with the tour leader from & back Gauteng and did **both tours**.

Price includes: Accommodation for 6 nights (B&B), one light supper, a tour leader with his own vehicle, all administration and leading of the tour (including booking of accommodation, meals & excursions, etc.), high frequency two-way radio per vehicle to use during the tour, LOTS of relevant info, lots of photos, daily briefings of the tour, limited vehicle breakdown support, **group safety**, new friends & new routes.

Tour price excludes: All other meals on tour, fuel for vehicle, Comprehensive Travel Insurance, gratuities, entry fees to venues or places, drinks, breakdown recovery costs and personal expenses.

Accommodation: We stay overnight in a good guest house in Stellenbosch, walking distance from various good restaurants in CBD of town.

Breakfast: All breakfasts will be enjoyed at the guest house.

Dinner: All other meals are **optional**, but budget for about R300+ pp/dinner. Dinner will be enjoyed at various restaurants.

Deposit: At least 25% of the tour price with the booking, another 25% three (3) months before departure date (21st June 2025) and the outstanding balance by latest 6 weeks before departure date (10th August 2025). Only space for 22 people per road trip. Book **NOW**.

If booked within the 3 months period prior to departure of the Road Trip, 50% payment is needed.

If booked within the 6 weeks period prior to departure of the Road Trip, full payment is needed.

Take on tour (suggested): Your vehicle, your family & friends, pocket money, a smile and goodwill. Some other extras could include: Sneakers (walking shoes), a hat, binoculars, toilet paper, wet wipes, coffee flask, camera, torch and sunglasses.

Vehicle: Any sedan, 4 x 2, or SUV vehicle with good ground clearance, for when traveling on the gravel roads, is suitable for the tour. We do **not** speed whilst on tour, but we expect all vehicles to travel at the speed set by the tour leader.



Who should go on this tour: People who love travelling, enjoy back roads, singles, couples, those who have never been to the Boland & Overberg regions and would like to enjoy the natural beauty and friendliness of the people; people who are unfamiliar with driving at foreign places; people who'd prefer to travel with other people in a **safe group environment**; people who don't like getting lost, those who'd like to be well informed as they drive along, those who like driving their own cars, people who like sharing their lives, interest, knowledge, fun and care with others. People who enjoy life at an easy pace.

Who should not go this tour: Moaners, groaners, whiners, speedsters, hooligans, boozers, people who can't drive on a gravel road, etc. People talking about their illnesses, pains, medicines used, operations they've had, etc.

What will you gain? Lots of enrichment in your life. New roads & routes, new place and people, beautiful nature and kind people. Lots of interesting info. Friends for life.

VHF Radio: We provide each vehicle with a two-way radio for the duration of the tour in order to communicate with everyone. It charges on the vehicle's cigarette lighter. (Please make sure your vehicle's cigarette lighter is working **before** the tour starts).

Money: A credit card, plus some cash, will be needed.

Fuel & Toilets: We'll stop regularly.

Clothing: Casual.

Excursions: Entry fees are not included in the tour price. You can book and pay an excursion on the day of arrival at the venue. Additional excursions on this tour are limited.

What to expect:

An orderly and well planned Road Trip, with a few surprises en route. Good food, a beautiful country, interesting roads and routes, tar and gravel roads, mountain passes and small towns, cute shops and road stalls, friendly people and something new...

We are looking forward to welcoming you on this Road Trip.

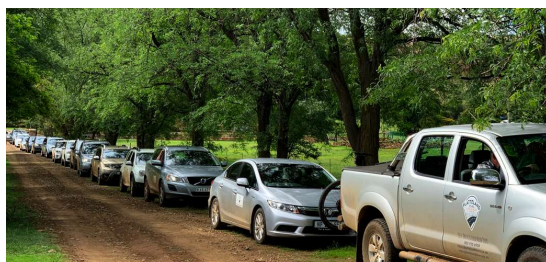

Day # 1 **Guest House, Stellenbosch**

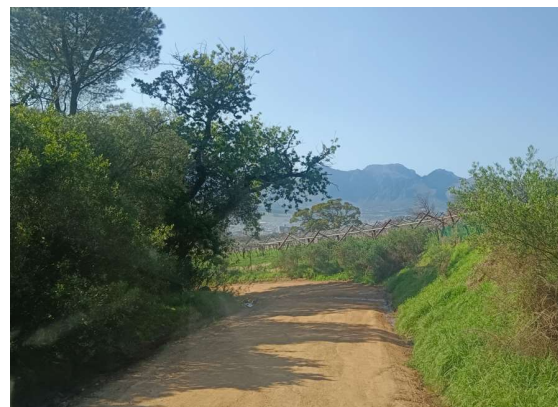
- 15h00 - 17h00 Book in

Days # 2 **From Stellenbosch traveling a circular route to the North**

338 Km

- 09h00 Departure from Guest House
Traveling Northwards to Paarl Mountain, Afrikaanse Taalmonument, Wellington, Bainskloof Pass, Breede River, Witels, Ceres, Gydo Pass, Koue Bokkeveld, Slanghoek valley, Old du Toitskloof Pass and Klein Drakenstein are some of the places to be visited – including an interesting ‘padstal’

Days # 3 **From Stellenbosch traveling a circular route to the Cape Peninsula** **235 Km**

09h00 Departure from Guest House
The Cape Peninsula will be traversed today, including False Bay, Muizenberg, Boyes' Drive, Simon's Town, Red Hill, Just Nuisance's grave, Cape Point area, Kommetjie, Chapman's Peak, Hout Bay (for 'slap chips & fish'), Bantry Bay, Table Mountain, Lion's Head and Cape Town

Days# 4 **From Stellenbosch traveling a circular route to the Inland** **170 Km**

09h00 Departure from Guest House
Travel inland to Pniel, Helshoogte, Franschhoek, Theewaterskloof Dam, van der Stel Pass, Houwhoek Inn, Arabella, Peregrine Farms Stall, Sir Lowry's Pass and beautiful yellow canola lands.

18h30 Dinner in Stellenbosch
Overnight in Guest House



Days # 5 **From Stellenbosch traveling a circular route to the West Coast** **411 Km**

09h00 Departure from Guest House
Today is flower-watching-day when visiting the West Coast National Park outside Langebaan & Saldanha Bay. It is end of the Namaqualand flowers season and the National Park hosts a variety of Fynbos, flowers and natural beauty. A visit to the Fossil Park is an interesting stop.

18h30 Dinner in Stellenbosch

Days # 6 **From Stellenbosch traveling a circular route to the Overberg** **360 Km**

09h00 Departure from Guest House
The Overberg region hosts a number of small towns and beautiful farms. Today you'll travel to Grabouw, Viljoen's Pass, Greyton, Akkedisberg Pass, Stanford, Hermanus. Karweiderskraal Pass, Kleinmond, Rooiels, Clarens Drive and Somerset West.

Day # 7 **From Stellenbosch to Mossel Bay (optional)** **392 Km**

09h00 Departure for home or for the Southern Cape Mountain Passes Road Trip
End of tour

Note: We did not include all the mountain passes' and towns' names that we'll be traveling over and though in the above daily itinerary.



MORE INFO ABOUT THE TRAVEL OPTIONS:

OPTION # 1: If you live in Gauteng (or other Northern provinces) and would like to travel in your own vehicle to the Western Cape, you may travel along, over two nights, with the tour leader.

Departure is on Friday morning, 19th September 2025, @ 06h00, from the Engen One-Stop on the N1 at Grasmere, Gauteng to a guest farm outside Colesberg. Accommodation is at a very special venue in the Colesberg district with links to a well-known sports person.

The second night (Saturday) is in the Swartberg Hotel in the picturesque town of Prince Albert in the Karoo.

Costs for two nights' accommodation, B&B, is R2400 per person sharing.

Please indicate on your Booking Form if you would like to make use of this option.

OPTION # 4: This Western Cape Road Trip is immediately followed by a **Southern Cape Mountain Passes 8- day/7-nights Road Trip** in the George, Knysna & Oudtshoorn region where you'll be able to traverse more than 60 mountain passes.

If you have booked and participated in the Western Cape Mountain Passes tour from Sunday 21st September 2025 and you want to participate in the Southern Cape Mountain Passes Road Trip from Saturday the 27th September to Saturday 4th October 2025, you should obtain the Info Doc and Booking Form for that tour from us.

You are welcome to travel with the group leader from Stellenbosch to the start of the Southern Cape tour outside Mossel Bay, on Saturday, 27th Sept 2025, in your own vehicle. No overnight accommodation en route is needed.

You can travel after the Southern Cape tour back to Gauteng again with the tour leader, sleeping two nights en route OR continue with your own journey. See the Southern Cape Tour's Info Doc.
